The master of architecture program is a design-based program that prepares all students, with or without an architectural background, for their professional architectural practice. This program leads to professional licensure in the US.

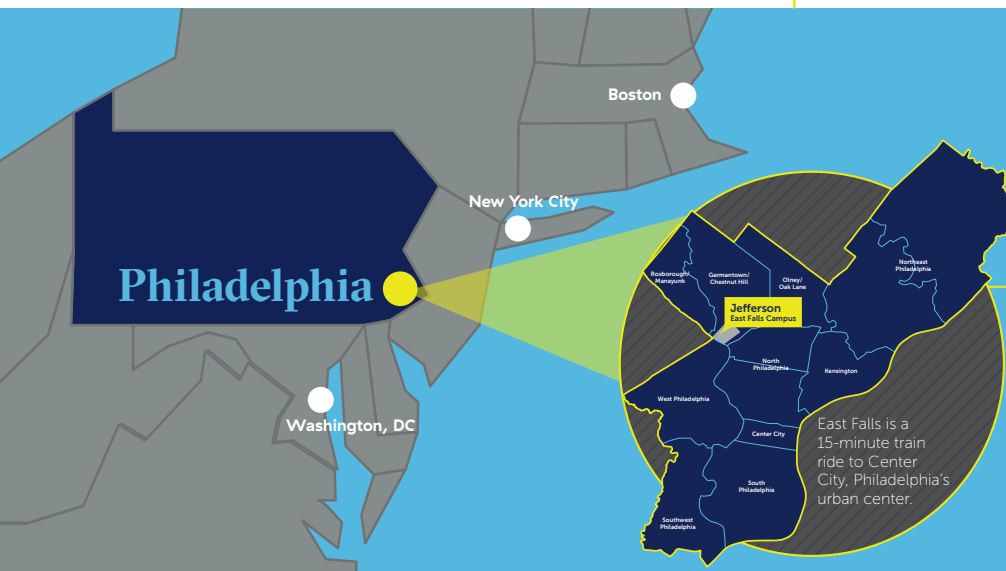
